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

Foreword

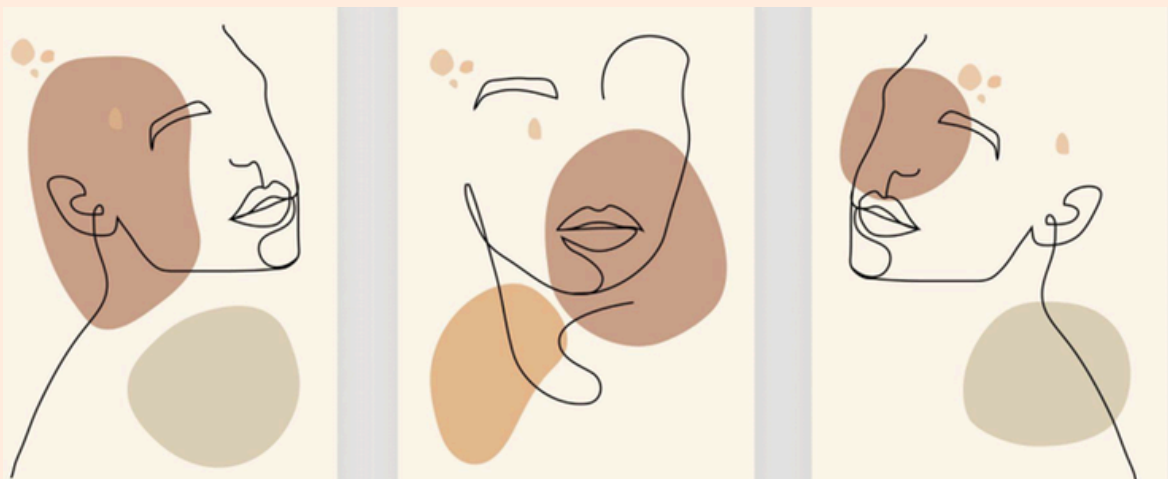

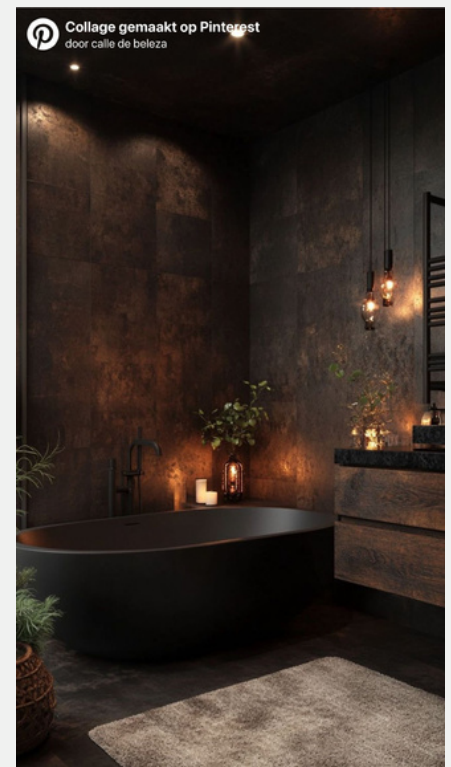
Chapter 7 – Black | Elegance and Power

Choose two to three colors that reflect your personality, such as green, burgundy, or purple.

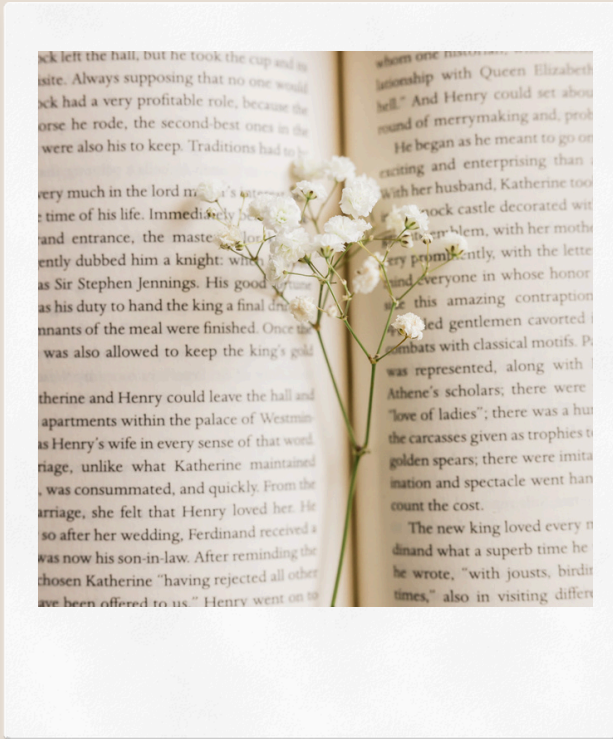
Step 4: Accent colors (± 10%)

Amber – Eternal Sunset

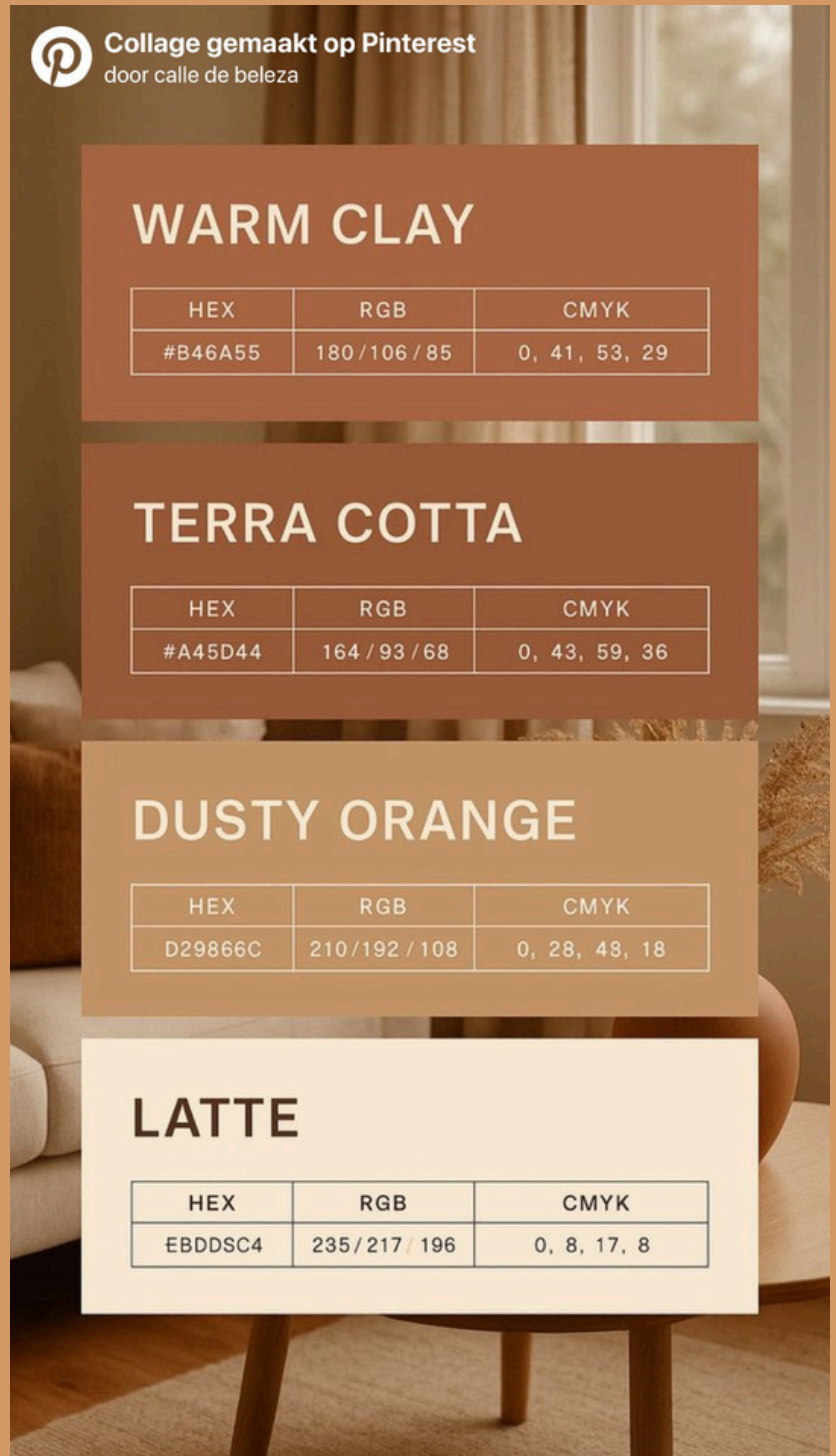
Amber brings comfort.
